## Programs at Camp

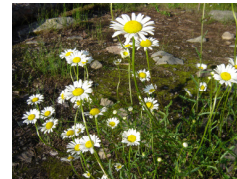
### ORCKA Canoeing and Kayaking Courses:

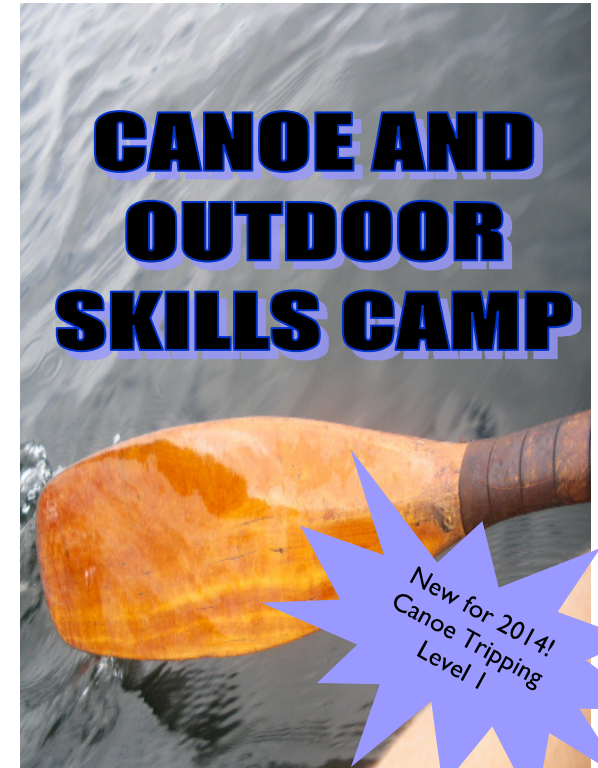
